EVENTS ENTERED

Players must be within or under the age group entered as at the last day of the month in which the tournament plays. A player may enter a maximum of two age groups - either 10's & 12's or 14's & 16's, or Open and 16's

- 10's age group (Sat 2nd Oct -Sun 3rd Oct 2021)
- 12's age group (Mon 4th Oct -Tues 5th Oct 2021)
- 14's age group (Sat 2nd Oct -Sun 3rd Oct 2021)
- 16's age group (Mon 4th Oct -Tues 5th Oct 2021)
- Open Event (Sat 2nd Oct -Sun 3rd Oct 2021)

ENTRY FEES

- One Event (includes singles & doubles) = \$50
- Two Events (includes singles & doubles) = \$80

TOURNAMENT NOTES AND REGULATIONS

1. The tournament is open to all members of Clubs, Associations and Schools that are affiliated to NZ Tennis.
2. The tournament will be conducted under the International Rules of Tennis, the Rules and Regulations and the Code of Conduct of New Zealand Tennis Inc. The New Zealand Tennis Code of Conduct will be posted at the Tournament venue and will be strictly adhered to.
3. It is expected that all players and parents will participate with discipline, honesty and fair play. Appropriate action can, and will be used by the Tournament Committee under the International Rules of Tennis if needed.
4. All players must wear approved tennis clothes and non-marking shoes.
5. All matches in the main draw, except 10's, will be best of two tie breaker sets with a super tiebreaker (first to 10 points) in place of the third set unless the Tournament Committee decides otherwise. All doubles matches will be best of two sets with a super tiebreaker (first to 10 points) in place of the third set. All games in the Consolation draws, will be best of two sets with a super tiebreaker (first to 10 points) to decide the third set unless the Tournament Committee decides otherwise. For the 10's, the matches will be the best of two short sets first to 4 games with a tie breaker at 4 all, with just a tiebreaker played to decide the third set. The 10 & under age event will use green dot balls, all other events will use traditional full compression tennis balls.
6. All players must be prepared to umpire.
7. The Umpire's decision on a point of fact shall be final.
8. The warm up period shall not exceed five minutes.
9. Players must bring their own balls for warm up.
10. All Players will report to Wanganui Tennis club at the time of 8.30am.
11. All match results will be uploaded to Tennis NZ grading system.
12. Play will commence at 9am each day unless otherwise stated.
13. Parents, Coaches and spectators must not communicate with the players or be on the courts during a match.
14. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to restrict entries, alter, combine or cancel any grades that have less than 12 entries.
15. Weather permitting the tournament will consist of: Main Draw Singles and Doubles, Feed-in consolation plate, and special plate.
16. Entries must be accompanied with payment of the correct entry fee for the relevant age group.
17. Entry fee refunds for players withdrawing from a tournament must be received in writing and will be processed based on the following sliding scale:
 - A. All medically or non-medically supported withdrawals made before the entry deadline 28th September will be issued with a full refund of their entry fee.
 - B. Any medically supported withdrawals after 28th September will be issued a refund of 75% of their entry fee.
 - C. Any non-medical withdrawals after 28th September will be issued a refund of 50% of their entry fee.
